Home activities :

Beyond medical care, the center fosters a vibrant community through theater performances, picnics, reading sessions, and annual competitions. Children who adhere to treatment plans and maintain HbA1c levels below 7% receive recognition and rewards.



Additional initiatives include clothing drives, eyeglass distributions, Ramadan food baskets, and school supply donations. Celebrations such as Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha are also organized to bring joy to the children.

For young adults, the center provides professional integration programs to help them enter the workforce.

Our donors :

We benefit from the support of numerous national and international donors, such as O.N.A., promoters from Tangier, anonymous benefactors, as well as national and foreign private organizations.

Some benefactors sponsor one or more children, with an annual budget of 6,000 DH per child. Our annual budget:

The annual budget of the center amounts to approximately 1,950,000 DH, which is an average of 6,000 DH per child each year.



Our team :

The center benefits from the support of two specialized nurses: one from public health, and the other hired and paid by the center.

We also have an endocrinologist, Dr. Saïd Bensouda, a member of our club, who spares no effort in providing free consultations to the young residents of the center.

A management committee oversees the operation of the center, consisting of a director, a treasurer, facilitators, and members committed to the development and sustainability of the center. All are volunteers and members of the club.
